| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Smart skirts (below the knee length– covers the knee). ▪ Smart dress with short or full-length sleeves (Not sleeveless) and below the knee length ▪ Smart full-length trousers ▪ Make-up should be natural and not noticeable. ▪ Nails should be a natural or a pale colour. ▪ Hair must be a natural colour | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Smart suit consisting of blazer and trousers. ▪ Ties worn with a collared shirt. ▪ Hair must be a natural colour. |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Discreet jewellery: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ earrings (studs preferably and if hoops are worn, they should be no bigger than 1cm in diameter). ➢ one small nose stud. ➢ all jewellery must be removed for games. | |
| UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ T-shirts, polo, sports or sweatshirts ▪ crew neck tops, bare shoulders, low cut tops or midriiffs showing. ▪ Blouses with low necklines, slits, or cut-outs ▪ Stretchy, jersey, Lycra material ▪ Shorts ▪ Jeans, stretchy, jersey or Lycra/skinny-fit trousers, leggings or jeggings ▪ Skirts above the knee or excessive slits ▪ Tight or revealing outfits. ▪ Over-sized brand names, slogans or logos ▪ Jumpers may not be worn without a jacket | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tracksuits ▪ Hoodies ▪ No heel higher than an inch (no stiletto heels) ▪ Trainers/canvas shoes (that are not black leather) ▪ Ugg boots, flip flops or casual sandals such as Birkenstock ▪ Frayed, ripped or faded clothing ▪ Facial piercings are not allowed (for the exception of a small/discreet nose stud) ▪ Clothing for specific lessons, such as PE can only be worn on the days the student has games.
